

## Gent synchronous wall clock

Figure 1 shows a Gent synchronous electric wall clock. The white metal case is 12½" diameter × 2¼" deep. The dial is 11" diameter with black batons and hands, and a red seconds hand. It is marked 'GENT'. A rear view is shown in Figure 2, and a close up of the movement cover in Figure 3. Markings on the movement cover include 'nedklok'. What appears to be a repairer's mark is scratched on. The self starting movement was made by the Dutch company Nedklok B V Nederlandse Klokkenindustrie Amsterdam. The movement is unusual in that it has an earth terminal, with the terminal block outside the movement cover. The back of the clock is recessed so that the electrical socket supplying the clock, and associated wiring, can easily be concealed.
