

Fattorini synchronous mantel clock

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Figures 1, 2 A and 3 show a Fattorini synchronous electric mantel clock. The walnut case is $4\frac{3}{4}$ " high \times $9\frac{1}{4}$ " wide \times 3" deep. The serial number '2391' is stamped underneath, with '1963' hand written. The pentagonal dial is $3\frac{1}{2}$ " high \times 6" wide with a chrome bezel, and black Roman numerals and hands. It is marked 'FATTORINI & SONS, L^{TD}, BRADFORD.' A rear view is shown in Figure 4, and rear view with the cover removed to give access to the starter and hand set knobs in Figure 5. Markings on the movement cover include 'FERRANTI'. This is a Ferranti Model No. 110 insertion movement, date range 1934-1938. The movement is not self starting, and there is no seconds hand, but the rotating starter knob acts as a tell tale.

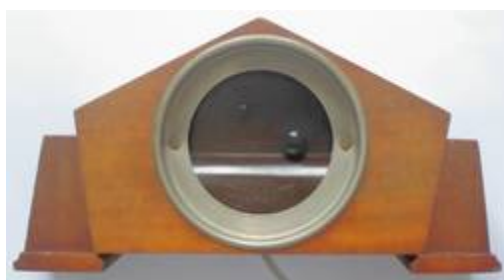
