

## Isis Model No.M49-1 alarm clock

Figures 1 and 2 show an Isis Model No.M49-1 synchronous alarm clock. There is no indication of where the clock was made so it is presumably foreign, probably American. The style is Novelty. It is for a 220 V 50 Hz supply. The white plastic case is 9 cm high  $\times$  28 cm wide. The dial is 5 cm diameter with white Arabic numerals and hands and a red alarm hand. The brand on the back is Isis. The patent number on the back is 1532476. This was issued to the Carson Corp in 1978 and covers the case design. There is a sticker on the inside of the back cover marked '10-79' so the clock was presumably made in October 1979. The movement is self starting. A rear view of the movement is shown in Figure 3. Moulded on markings include '120 V' and '60 Hz'. This suggests that the movement is a 220 V 50 Hz version of a movement originally designed for the American market. Figure 4 shows a top view of the movement, and Figure 5 a side view.

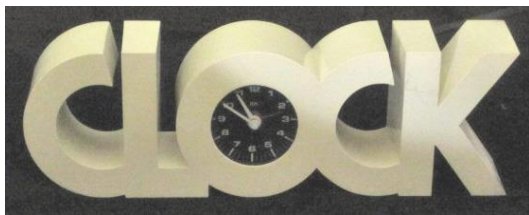

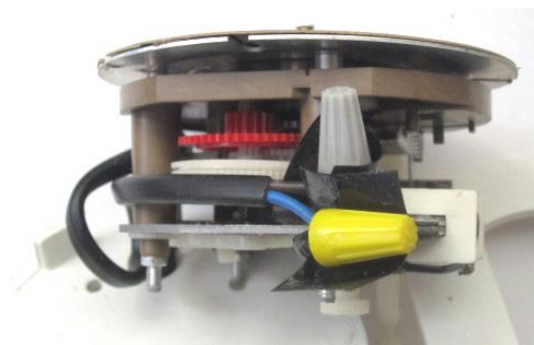

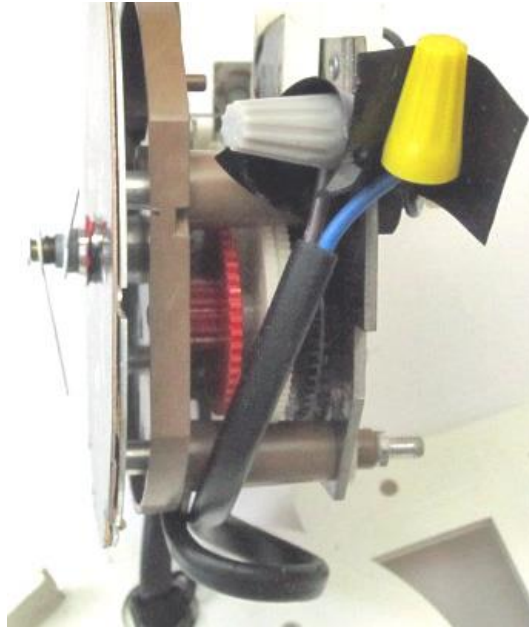
